ENTERING THE SHOW

To reduce costs and administration, entries for the Grand National Show are done online via the Tequine Showtime website www.tequinesolutions.net. If your horses or ponies are NOT registered IMHR, then you need to upload a copy of the CURRENT papers to Tequine Showtime.

Please email tequineshowtime@gmail.com if you require assistance with your online entries.

There are no refunds or credits once entries have closed.

Make sure you've met all the pre-requisites including:

- CURRENT registrations for all horses and ponies
- CURRENT IMHR membership for all handlers
- CURRENT IMHR registration for horses and ponies registered IMHR (even if additionally registered with another organisation)
- CURRENT IMHR registration for classes requiring IMHR registration such as Amateur and SIRES.

Pending registrations with other societies will <u>not</u> be accepted. Penalties apply to anyone found to be breaching these pre-requisites.

All horses and ponies must be entered using their full registered name. If the exhibit is not registered IMHR Inc, a colour copy of the registration papers must be uploaded into Tequine Showtime. All stallions 3 years and over must have a Certificate of Soundness (COS) on file. Stallions entered in the AMHA classes must have a current AMHA Veterinary Inspection - www.amha.org/pdf/show/VetStallionInspection.pdf

Once payment is confirmed in the Tequine Showtime system by the administrators, you will receive an Entry Confirmation via email. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to check this confirmation and ensure that the correct classes have been entered.

The age of youth and adult exhibitors is determined by actual age as at closing date for entries. For Three Day Event (3DE) competitors, horse and handler age is based on actual age on the first day of 3DE competition.

All exhibitors must acknowledge, accept and familiarise themselves with the IMHR Show Rules, any changes thereto and accept all direction by Show Committee prior to and during the event. Submitting an entry to the Grand National Show is confirming acceptance of these Conditions of Entry.

INTERNATIONAL JUDGE: WAYNE G. HIPSLEY

IMHR is extremely proud to announce **Wayne G. Hipsley BSc MSc** from Lexington, Kentucky USA will officiate at our Grand National.



Wayne will be judging the Youth Nationals on Monday followed by all classes on Wednesday, Thursday and Ring 1 on Friday. Local judges will be utilised for Tuesday, Friday Ring 2 and Saturday. Details will be provided once confirmed.

In 2020, this will be his third time to serve as an official for the IMHR as a judge for their National, now Grand National Miniature Horse Show. Over the years, he has watched the quality transition of the Miniature Horses in Australia, as well as the significant improvement of the presentations. He is especially impressed with the further diversification in the various uses and training (expansion of driving, dressage, etc.) of the breed in the class list. We must remember, showing is an important part of sustaining and growing the Miniature Horse breed.

The 2018 AMHA World Show was the fifth time he has the honor to serve as a judge for this important event in the AMHA calendar. Over these years, he has seen the evolution and improvement of the breed into a true

Miniature Horse through selective breeding enhanced by the emphasis of show ring competition. One of the greatest areas of improvement is with the development of talented driving horses in all divisions, something that owners and exhibitors along with their trainers need to be congratulated.

Wayne has been a licensed American Miniature Horse Association judge for over 30 years. During this time, he has assisted with the formation of the AMHA judge's education and licensing programs, serving as a seminar instructor and consultant to the AMHA Licensed Officials Committee. In addition, he has worked with development of AMHA rules and regulations, breed standards and international marketing of the breed.

Through the years, Wayne has conducted educational clinics and seminars pertaining to the Miniature Horse outside of the US borders in Australia, New Zealand, United Kingdom, Belgium, Czech Republic, Netherlands, France and South Africa. His central message has been and remains a focus on the American Miniature Horse and its "large horse in a small package" philosophy, while maintaining the standard of height and type.

He has judged over 100 American Miniature Horse shows during his career in 12 different countries. Through these opportunities, he has also had the pleasure of assessing and evaluating Miniature Horses with foreign foundations in their native country and measure their progress to achieve the goal of a "large horse in a small package."

Wayne continues to enjoy his lifelong passion with horses on his farm in Paris, Kentucky, devoting part of the time to trail riding and equestrian consulting along with judging.

VENUE INFORMATION

The IMHR Grand National Show will be run at the Australian Equine and Livestock Events Centre (AELEC) at 503 Goonoo Goonoo Road, Tamworth in the main indoor arena. For more information about the venue, visit www.aelec.com.au and refer to their Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ) page: www.aelec.com.au/About-AELEC/FAQ/FAQ.

There is an ATM, cafeteria (during show times) and coin operated laundry facilities which takes one dollar coins. Change for the laundry can be obtained from the AELEC office during business hours only. The IMHR show office does <u>not</u> provide change for the laundry.

Exhibitors can arrive on site from Friday 20th March and must depart by Sunday 29th March.



STABLES AND STAYING ONSITE

Stables, parking and campsites must be booked directly with the venue and not through IMHR. You can book sites using the via www.nominate.com.au or you can call AELEC staff during business hours on (02) 6767 5658. AELEC will advise IMHR when the system is open for bookings. There is a detailed venue map on the Nominate and AELEC websites showing parking, campsites and stables so you can choose a camping or parking site near your horses.

The map also details sites suitable for tents. Ensure you only use areas designated for tents as pegs may damage the underground watering system.

Caravans are permitted and you must pay for a site for the van. Caravans can be hired locally through www.camplify.com.au.

Stable blocks have water and power in each of the stable rows. You are permitted to clip your horses in the stable walkways however, you must remove all hair and place in bins provided. Be mindful of your neighbours when using the walkways and emptying water buckets.

All sites behind the exhibitor gate are allocated must be paid for if you use them. This includes parking for additional cars and floats. Free parking for visitors or additional cars is available in the car park near the main entrance. Do not park or setup in any site that you have not been allocated at any time for any reason. This creates issues for other exhibitors who have booked and paid for their sites. Anyone using a site that they have not been allocated will need to move. Refusal to do so will result in expulsion from the show and forfeiture of all entries paid.









MOTEL ACCOMMODATION

If you'd prefer not to camp on site at AELEC, there is ample motel accommodation options in Tamworth. Some also allow pets. Visit the tourism website www.destinationtamworth.com.au for more details.



GOLF CARTS & SCOOTERS

Golf carts are permitted at AELEC and are available for hire from DTM Tamworth. Please see the DTM website for hire conditions. You must have a valid driver's license to book and operate a cart. There is a limit of 14 hired golf carts permitted at AELEC. Visit the DTM website for more information: www.dtmtamworth.com.au.

Private golf carts are permitted but may only be operated by adults with a valid driver's license. Be mindful of exhibitors, horses and children on pathways. Anyone found to be breaching this rule or is found to be driving any cart in a reckless manner will be asked to leave the site and forfeit all monies paid.

Electric scooters and bikes are permitted however, all children must be supervised when using them and care must be taken when using pathways. Anyone found to be operating them in a reckless manner will be asked to leave the site and forfeit all monies paid.



Dogs must be supervised always be kept under control on leash. Owners of dogs found loose may be asked to leave the complex and forfeit all monies paid. Please ensure you clean up after your dog or they may be banned from the arena area. Dogs are NOT permitted in the seating area or the marshalling area of the indoor arena.



HORSES AND PONIES FOR SALE

Exhibitors are given the option of identifying horses or ponies exhibiting at the show that are for sale when doing entries. A sale fee per horse for sale is payable, and a \$\$ notation will be made in the catalogue next to that exhibits name indicating that the horse or pony is for sale. A list of horses for sale with relevant contact information will be available at the Show Office for potential buyers at no charge. Prices for horses or ponies will be via private negotiation between buyer and seller.









YOUTH COACHING

In preparation for the Youth Nationals, Doug Farmer of Doug Farmer Training Clinic and Nicole Kelly of Sapphire Park Miniature Horses have teamed up to offer the Youth Exhibitors coaching tips before the Youth Nationals. They will be available in the main arena from 8am on Monday so make sure you take advantage of this generous opportunity and grab some valuable tips before your classes. RIBBONS AND AWARDS

All National Champion classes shall place from 1^{st} to 10^{th} (excluding prizemoney classes such as SIRES and Sweepstakes). SIRES classes shall be placed to 6^{th} place and Sweepstakes to 5^{th} .

All placegetters shall receive a sash. Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion shall receive a sash with rosette. Champion of Champions award winners will receive a sash, embroidered rug with sponsors name if applicable, trophy and garland. Supreme award winners will receive a trophy and sash. Additional prizes may be awarded if sponsored.



TRAINERS CHALLENGE

This challenge is for recognised trainers to demonstrate their skill and ability to bring out the best in horses that they are not familiar with. Exhibitors may nominate horses to be available for the challenge. Trainers draw a horse from a hat and have 30 mins to work with that horse.

The challenge event consists of a halter class followed by a condensed hunter course. The trainer with the highest points over the two events will be declared the winner and will win 100% of the entry money for that event as prizemoney.









The horse will perform three disciplines in one class.

- Harness Driving (20 points)
- Halter (20 points)
- Hunter (Abbreviated Course) (20 points)

All three disciplines to be judged and scored. Total is then combined for final placings. Any horse disqualified from one discipline is disqualified from the class.

There will be one class and is open to mares, stallions and geldings of all heights.

Each discipline will be subject to the open class rule for that discipline unless otherwise stated in class description. Horse must be three years of age or older. One Assistant or Header (MUST BE AN ADULT) will be allowed in the arena only for the heading and unharnessing of the horse.

Exhibitor and assistant must be properly attired.

Class Procedure:

- 1. Horses will enter the arena at a collected trot then perform a working trot and walk in both directions of the arena then stand in a line up as indicated by the Ring Steward. Headers will be asked to enter the arena. Horses will be asked to rein back.
- 2. The call judge will blow a whistle signalling the driver and header, as a team, to remove cart and harness from horse and do any grooming or halter changes. For purpose of safety, the cart must be removed from the horse before the horse is unbridled. Failure to do so; will be disqualification and excused from the arena. Each horse and handler will go to the rail in order of completion. After a two minute time limit the call judge will blow the whistle for time. Any horse not removed from cart or harness will be disqualified. Headers will be asked to exit the arena with cart and harness, in an orderly manner.
- 3. Horses are to remain in the same order for the rest of the class.
- 4. Horses will be judged at halter. Stock Horses showing in Versatility MUST wear stock type/western show halters. No teeth will be checked. Horses will line up head to tail for inspection. Horses may be asked to work out for the judge.
- 5. Horses will jump a hunter style course consisting of a maximum of three (3) jumps and must include one change of direction. Course is to demonstrate horses' style, manner and way of going. Any faults are calculated as per standard Hunter rules.











BEST DRESSED STABLES

Exhibitors are encouraged to decorate their stables to promote their horses and studs. In accordance with AELEC rules, please ensure that the decorations do not damage any part of the stable or stable area.

To be eligible, please upload your photos to the IMHR main Facebook page - www.facebook.com/imhrinc/ once stable display is setup and include the tag #IMHRNats. We encourage exhibitors to share their photos on social media to gain support, however, only 'likes' recorded on the IMHR Facebook page count towards the final winning result.

Winner will receive \$100 cash.



MARSHALLING

Exhibitors must be present in the marshalling area for their class at least 5 minutes before the end of the previous class. Notification of gear and handler changes must be made to the Gate Steward and if time permits, a maximum 3-minute allowance will be made. All equipment required for gear and handler changes must be brought to the marshalling area. Once the gate has been closed by the gate steward entry will not be permitted into that class.

Appropriate footwear (no thongs or sandals) must be worn in the marshalling area or you will be asked to leave the area. Failure to do so may result in disciplinary action.

Alcohol is not permitted in the marshalling area. Dogs are not permitted in the marshalling area.

It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to ensure that they monitor the progress of the classes and are present in time for their classes. They must also ensure that they have enough handlers, gear and equipment to ensure arrival for classes in a timely manner.

Any horse not listed in the steward sheet for that class will NOT be permitted to enter the ring. Changes in class entries due to heights or substitution must be annotated on the steward's sheet by Show Management or the exhibitor must hold the appropriate authorisation paperwork to present to the steward. If you have changed classes due to height, the gate steward can verify this via the height stamped on the exhibitor number.

Ensure you are at the marshalling area in time to resolve any issues.



IMHR National Show Perpetual Trophy

Marie Raines Inspirational Award

In Honor of Marie Ann Raines ~ 27 June 1954 - 13 July 2015



In mid-2015 the miniature horse community lost one of its most admired and respected enthusiasts. Marie Raines was one of the founders of Koriana Park — a stud based in Western New South Wales, which pioneered the breeding of little horses, and which continues to be recognised for the quality of its carefully considered breeding program.

For Marie, showing horses was very much a family affair involving her husband Viv and daughter Kylie. However, Marie's notion of 'family' extended far beyond her immediate household. Marie was an exceptionally kind and generous horsewoman, always quick to lend a hand to exhibitors who may have been struggling to manage horses singlehandedly, or to keep a watchful eye on children while mum or dad were in the show ring. Perhaps that's why almost everyone referred to Marie simply as 'mum'.

Marie's calm nature saw horses warm to her very quickly, and a few gentle words were often all it took for her to settle excitable youngstock. She worked tirelessly for the miniature horse community, helping to organise and support shows in her local area, giving all enthusiasts an equal opportunity to have their moment of victory in the show ring. Yet Marie was content to stay out of the limelight herself.

In June 2012, Marie faced her greatest challenge. Diagnosed with melanoma, Marie, Viv and Kylie would regularly make the 1,000 kilometre round-trip from their home in Warren to Sydney to undergo treatment. Anyone who has ever been brushed by cancer will know just how debilitating treatment can be. But Marie never lost hope, never gave up — and never lost her enthusiasm to share a smile, a laugh and warm hugs with those around her.

After three difficult years, on 13 July 2015, Marie's journey came to an end, and she passed away surrounded by her loving family.

While Marie is no longer with us, the memories of her kindness and warmth will always shine brightly.

The Marie Raines Inspirational Award embodies Marie's spirit of generosity, selflessness and true passion for miniature horses. This award acknowledges the IMHR National Show exhibitor who shares those same qualities - helping to make the show more pleasant for those around them, inspiring others to aim for the stars, and always putting the welfare of their horses above all else.

To the winner of the Marie Raines Inspirational Award, we honour you just as we give tribute to the remarkable woman after whom this award is named. You are a true source of inspiration, and we know Marie shares your joy in being selected as this year's recipient.

All horses and ponies need to be measured to attend the National Show.

Collect your exhibitor bag from the Show Office (see Show Office Opening Hours) prior to attending measuring. This bag contains your exhibit numbers which will be stamped with the horse or pony's height at the measuring bay. It will also contain your Show Catalogue. Use that publication to confirm your classes and to make notes in, especially if your horse measures into a different class rather than the one entered. It is your responsibility to enter the correct class based on your horse's height which will be written on the back of your exhibit number.

Horses or ponies being used for the Youth Nationals do not need to be measured for these events but must be measured to enter other events at the National Show.

Be prepared for measuring:

- Know your horse or pony's full registered name
- Understand the IMHR Height For Age rules
- Know what height your horse or pony needs to be to qualify for the classes you've entered so that you know if you need to move 'up' or 'down' a class
- Bring enough handlers to hold horses and ponies while your team is being measured
- Be ready to be measured when it's your turn by removing all rugs
- Remember to request a last hair of the mane measurement if entering AMHA classes

Measuring times

Sunday 22nd March – 2pm to 6pm Monday 23rd March – 3pm to 7pm Tuesday 24th March – 7am to 8am Wednesday 25th March – 7am to 8am Thursday 26th March – 7am to 8am Friday 27th March – 7am to 8am Saturday 28th March – 7am to 8am

Unless your horse or pony is 5 years and over (actual) and holds a Permanent Height Card they will need to be measured at the National Show unless officially measured at an eligible IMHR show less than 3 months prior. More information about Permanent Height Cards is available on the IMHR website. Miniature, Small and Little Horses and Miniature and Small Ponies are measured at the highest point of the wither and must meet the IMHR Height For Age to compete.

American Shetlands and APSB Shetland Ponies must not exceed the height requirements for registration with the relevant organisations.

Calculations for Hi Point Breeder and Hi Point IMHR Exhibitor are calculated as follows:

2 points	1 point
National Champion	National Reserve Champion
National Grand Champion	National Reserve Grand Champion

AMHA, American Shetland, APSB Shetland, 3DE, Amateur, Novice, SIRES, Fancy Dress and Youth events are not included for overall Hi Point Breeder and Exhibitor awards.

Hi Point Harness is determined by the results of the open harness class, obstacle class and long-reining class.

Once awarded, Hi Point results are final.

For those enrolled in the IMHR National Hi Point program, the National Show is TRIPLE points. See the IMHR website and Online Shop for more information on the IMHR Hi Point program. You do not need to be enrolled in the National Hi Point program to accrue Hi Points at the National Show for the National Show Hi Point awards. Awards for the National Hi Point awards are made at the Grand National Show Dinner.

GRAND CHAMPIONS

All first and second place getters in eligible National Champion halter classes must present for the Grand Championship awards unless officially scratched.

To be eligible to win a National Grand Champion you must have entered all qualifying events.

The winner of the Grand Champion Youth award is determined by the results of the respective Youth Showmanship, Trail and Hunter classes. In the event of a tie, the exhibitor with the highest trail score is deemed the winner. Any further tie breaks are determined by the judge. Grand Champion Youth Harness is determined by the result of the Youth Harness and Youth Longreining classes. Tie breaks are determined by the judge. Grand Champion Youth Sporting is determined by the result of the boot race and egg and spoon race for exhibitors aged 3-4 and the results of the respective bending, flag and barrel race for other Youth exhibitors.

Grand Champion Harness



WHAT ARE SIRES FUTURITIES?

A once-off nomination fee is paid for a stallion. All progeny (past, present and future) are eligible to enter the SIRES Futurities prizemoney events at Nationals and other selected shows. **To ensure we can confirm eligibility, all horses entering the SIRES classes must now be registered IMHR.**

The nominated stallion must be registered IMHR and have a Certificate of Soundness on file with IMHR.

Prizemoney won by progeny is awarded at the show to the exhibitor of the winning horse(s). The total amount of prizemoney awarded is added to the running total of prizemoney won by that stallion's progeny to establish a ranking.

To check if a horse you own is eligible, go to the IMHR website Forms Page and check the List of Nominated Stallions. If one of these stallions is the sire of your horse, then your horse is eligible to enter these classes.


