- ✓ Ensure you also record a last hair of the mane measuring for horses entering the AMHA classes.
- ✓ Include copies of registrations if horse/pony is not registered IMHR otherwise <u>you will be charged</u> \$20 re-processing fee.
- ✓ Copies of both sides of registration is required for all horses entering AMHA classes.
- ✓ Pending registrations for other societies will NOT be accepted.
- ✓ You must be a financial member of IMHR to enter and all horses/ponies must be owned/leased by you.
- ✓ You must be able to get all horses/ponies to measuring at the specified times.
- ✓ NO whips in halter classes this includes Miniature Ponies.
- ✓ Check the new rules for Amateur eligibility and ensure you are eligible before entering the Amateur classes
- ✓ NO refunds or credits under any circumstances.
- ✓ It is YOUR responsibility to get your horse/pony into the ring on time.
- ✓ The compulsory catalogue/admin fee is COMPULSORY.
- ✓ If not already on file with IMHR, a certificate of soundness MUST be supplied for all stallions 3 years and over.
- ✓ Stallions 3 years and over entering the AMHA classes must include a current AMHA Stallion Verification Report.

About Our Show

The 2015 IMHR National Championship Show will commence on Wednesday 11th March and finish with the last class on Sunday 15th March.

Venue: Australian Equine & Livestock & Events Centre (AELEC), Goonoo Goonoo Road, Tamworth NSW, Australia.

Incomplete entries <u>will be charged</u> a reprocessing fee. Please check your entries carefully and keep a copy for your records. **Entries close 14th February 2015** – no extensions.

Entry Procedure

All entries must be made following the official procedure set out by IMHR Inc. Entries must contain the full registered name of the horse or pony, registration number and if not registered with IMHR Inc, a legible copy of both sides of registration papers.

Exhibits in the AMHA USA classes must also include a copy of their AMHA papers PLUS a vet certificate for stallions 3 years and over.

If the exhibit is registered IMHR, the IMHR registration must be current with no upgrade or transfers pending even if dual registered with another society.

Pending registration for other societies will NOT be accepted. Current papers must be produced before entry closing date or entries will NOT be accepted.

All payment for entries must be received by the IMHR National Office by the due date unless prior arrangements have been approved. All cheques/money orders must be made payable to IMHR Inc. Direct deposits and PayPal must include a copy of the receipt. Credit card payments are also available.

You will receive an entry confirmation via email. Please check your entry confirmation thoroughly and advise of any errors / omissions. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to ensure that you check the entry confirmation and that you have entered the correct classes. There are no refunds or credits for classes that you have entered incorrectly.

Entry Fees

Payment of all entry fees must be received by National Office no later than the published closing date.

Entries received later than the closing date and prior to catalogue finalisation date will be assessed a late penalty fee per horse. There is no guarantee that entries received after the closing date will be accepted. Entries that are accepted by IMHR Inc. must have late penalty fee paid prior to show date.

Note: For the 2015 National Show, class entry fees are **half price for owners from Tasmania**.

There shall be <u>no refunds or credits</u> under any circumstances.

Invalid Payments

Payments returned as unpaid for any reason are regarded as a serious offence and a payment re-processing fee of \$50 will be assessed for every returned cheque or invalid direct deposit. All debts must be paid including re-processing fees before entries will be confirmed.

Entry Conditions

All exhibitors must be current financial members of IMHR and must be the registered owner or lessee of all entered exhibits. No exceptions.

All handlers must be financial members or have paid the insurance levy and signed the waiver. It is the exhibit owner's responsibility to ensure all handlers are eligible to enter the show ring in accordance with this condition.

All exhibits must hold current registrations with IMHR or a recognised Miniature Horse or Pony organisation. Exhibits in the Amateur Showcase and Guinness World Record attempt must hold current registrations with IMHR.

Exhibits entering the Miniature Pony classes must be registered as Miniature Ponies. Horses may not enter the pony classes and ponies may not enter the horse classes – even if dual registered.

American Shetland exhibits not exceeding 42" are eligible to enter halter classes denoted as exclusively for American Shetlands. American Shetlands may not enter the Miniature Horse, Small Horse or Little Horse halter classes – even if dual registered.

American Shetlands may enter the following performance events:

- Hunter
- Trail
- Show Jumper (+ Six Bar, Fault & Out)
- Three Day Event (3DE)

American Shetlands entered in the above performance events must enter the appropriate age and height as per their show measurement.

Anyone found to be breaching these conditions, may have all entries cancelled without refund, all awards revoked and be subject to further disciplinary action by the National Committee.

Substitutions / Scratchings

Substitutions for a horse that is being scratched from that class during the show are permitted at a \$10 office charge per change.

Exhibitor must already be entered in class and only substituting the horse.

All changes must be made by 6pm the day before the class to allow steward sheets to be updated.

Additional Entries

Additional entries for horses already entered in the National Show are permitted at double entry fee

All changes must be made by 6pm the day before the class to allow steward sheets to be updated.

Horses for Sale

On the official entry form exhibitors are given the option of identifying horses or ponies exhibiting at the show that are for sale.

A \$10.00 fee per horse for sale is payable, and a \$\$ notation will be made in the catalogue next to that exhibits name indicating that the horse or pony is for sale. A list of horses for sale with relevant contact information will be available at the Show Office for potential buyers at no charge. Prices for horses or ponies will not be listed and will be via private negotiation between buyer and seller.

A parade of horses and ponies for sale will be made available on Wednesday on the conclusion of the day's events. Exhibitors are encouraged to bring promotional literature to hand out during this parade. Exhibitors must wear the horse or ponies exhibit number to ensure that it is identifiable from the stands.

Stallion Certificate of Soundness

All Senior Stallions must have a Certificate of Soundness on file with IMHR before being permitted to compete. If horse is not registered IMHR Inc. then copy of Certificate of Soundness must accompany entries.

Stallions showing in AMHA classes aged 3 years and over must include a current AMHA Stallion Verification Report. Please see AMHA section of this Show Premium for more information.

Measuring

All exhibits must be measured by the official measurer(s). It is a condition of entry that you accept the measurement of the official measurer(s). It is the responsibility of the exhibitor that all horses compete in the correct height class as per final measurement.

Official measuring will take place at the venue in Stable Block A (car park end) at the following time:

Tues 10th March midday - 5pm

All horses and ponies on site MUST be measured on Tuesday. It is your responsibility to plan your trip to Nationals accordingly to ensure you make these official measuring times.

Measuring at other times is by appointment ONLY as there is limited time available and MUST finish by 8am.

Limited appointments may be available for the following days:

Wed 11th March 7am – 8am (by appt. only) Thu 12th March 7am – 8am (by appt. only) Fri 13th March 7am – 8am (by appt. only) Sat 14th March 7am – 8am (by appt. only)

There shall be <u>no measuring during show times</u>.

Failure to arrive in time for Official Measuring or your appointment will incur a \$50 fee imposed for each horse to be measured.

There is no guarantee that an official measurer will be available which may result in measuring being deferred until the next available appointment the next morning. There is no refund for classes missed due to missing allocated measuring times.

Senior Horse Height Cards

Horses presenting at the measuring bay may be eligible to request a Permanent Height Card via the Online Shop.

Cards can be issued for horses that are 3 years and over. This card is valid for all IMHR feature shows for the 12 months following the National Show for 3 and 4 year olds and permanently for 5 year old horses.

Measuring Process

The measuring steward shall record the height of the exhibit. A copy of the final measurements shall be given to the exhibitor to allow them to record the heights for their own records and to ensure they enter the correct classes if there is a change from original entry.

AMHA exhibitors please ensure that the measurer also records the measurement at last hair of the mane for AMHA measurement records.

Any exhibitor wishing to have their exhibit remeasured may bring the exhibit back two (2) times to be measured and may accept any of the measurements taken.

Please bring sufficient handlers to the measuring bay to assist with rugs to prevent delays. All rugs must be removed for measurement. Please ensure your handlers are familiar with the exhibits name.

Height for Age

IMHR Constitution specifies that all horses are measured at the highest point of the withers for the open classes. AMHA USA has separate guidelines for measuring for the AMHA USA classes only.

Horses are measured as per their 1st August age not actual age.

HEIGHT FOR AGE RULES

Miniature Horse

- Weanlings must not exceed 30"
- Yearlings must not exceed 32"
- Two Year Old must not exceed 33"
- Mature horses must not exceed 34.5"

Small Horse

- Weanlings must not exceed 34"
- Yearlings must not exceed 36"
- Two Year Olds must not exceed 37"
- Mature horses must not exceed 38.5"

Little Horse

- Weanlings must not exceed 38"
- Yearlings must not exceed 40"
- Two Year Olds must not exceed 41"
- Mature horses must not exceed 42"

As per AMHA guidelines, a mature horse must not exceed 34".

Sponsorship/Advertising

Sponsorship and advertising opportunities are available for the National Show. All sponsors will receive promotion in the Show Catalogue and engraving on trophies (where applicable).

Full colour advertising is also available. Ads must be A4 portrait and in print ready JPG format and received by entry closing.

Please use the IMHR Online Shop, IMHR Work Order or National Show Entry form for all sponsorship bookings and payments. Please do not email the information without completing booking paperwork or inclusion cannot be guaranteed.

Merchandise

National Show and IMHR logo merchandise may be available for purchase at the show or may be pre-ordered via the Online Shop and collected at the show.

Exhibitor Bags

All exhibitors will receive an exhibitor bag with their Show Catalogue and exhibit numbers.

We are offering the opportunity for studs and businesses to take advantage of an advertising opportunity by placing promotional material and samples into these bags. You must supply the material to be placed into the bags. Bookings and payment can be done via the Online Shop. Material must be received by entry closing date or inclusion cannot be quaranteed.

Traders

All persons wishing to conduct trade at the IMHR National Show must seek permission from the IMHR Committee and provide contribution to the event by way of sponsorship.

This includes but is not limited to photography services, clipping and grooming services, selling of any goods or services including homemade rugs and equipment.

Trade stalls in the main arena attract an additional fee set by AELEC. It is a condition that all businesses wishing to have a trade stall in the arena carry their own public liability insurance. Any person(s) found to be trading at the event without permission of the Committee shall be asked to leave the event and may not be permitted to attend future events.

Show Rules

It is a condition of entry that you understand and comply with all rules applicable to the National Show.

The IMHR National Show is covered by the rules listed in the IMHR Constitution, Show Rules Handbook and the IMHR Performance Handbook plus any additional rules outlined in this publication or as directed by Show Management.

Knowledge of IMHR Show Rules and Regulations, as well as the requirements for each of the classes entered, is the responsibility of the exhibitor.

Copies of the handbooks mentioned may be downloaded from the official IMHR website or members can order a printed copy via the Online Shop or Work Order.

Please take note of the dress code required for the National Show. All shirts must have sleeves or jackets must be worn. Singlet tops, tank tops or similar will not be permitted without a jacket. Exhibitors must ensure that outfits convey a professional image at all times. The outfit must cover shoulders and also from chest to knees. Handlers not suitably attired will be asked to leave the arena.

Displays of bad sportsmanship will NOT be tolerated. Exhibitors who disrespect other exhibitors, show management, committee, judges or any other person may, at the committee's discretion, be asked to leave the venue without refund or recourse and may be suspended from entering IMHR shows in future.

All exhibitors must ensure that handlers entering the ring are wearing the correct back number. Anyone not wearing the correct number or failing to wear a number at all will not be permitted into the ring. Classes will not be held up for those with incorrect or missing numbers.

Exhibitors are not permitted to <u>change</u> the colour of any horse (i.e. from bay to black or appaloosa to solid) or to add markings such as socks, face markings.

Protests

In the event of an exhibitor wishing to protest eligibility of another exhibitor or exhibit, a \$50 fee must be paid to the Protest Committee up front. This is refunded if protest is upheld.

Protests regarding eligibility for the class (height, age etc..) must be lodged with the Protest Committee within 20 minutes of class completion or it will not be accepted. Protests can only be made during or on completion of a class. Protests during the judging of Grand Championships will not be heard.

At no time will IMHR Inc. tolerate exhibitors approaching the Judge or Steward with regard to any decision or rule.

Protests of height measurements will be accepted up to 20 minutes after completion of measuring that exhibit. Exhibit will re-measured once only and this measurement shall be deemed final.

All protests must be made via the Show Office. Do not approach any committee members or exhibitors directly.

<u>Swabbing</u>

Drug testing may be carried out at IMHR shows including the National Show. It is a condition of entry that you agree to present your horse for swabbing if directed by Show Management.

Failure to do so will result in forfeiture of all awards and cancellation of any other entries for all horses entered by that exhibitor at the same show.


Further disciplinary action including expulsion may be taken for a positive swab result.

Whips In Halter Classes

Whips are not permitted in any halter class. Small hacking canes are allowed however, they must not come in contact with the horse or pony at any time. Whips are only permitted in classes that require them such as harness and lunge-line.

Dogs

Dogs must be under control (on leash) at all times. Owners of dogs found loose may be asked to leave the complex.



Venue Information



Access to the venue will be permitted on Saturday 7th March. Note that there will be another event running at the venue during that weekend.

Exhibitors with caravans must also pay applicable camping/parking fees for the parking space for the caravan.

Smoking

Smoking is NOT permitted in any buildings, stabling or restrooms. Smoking must be done outside and away from the stable area. Please dispose of butts in bins.

Decorations / Signage

Posters, flyers and other printed materials shall not be stapled or attached to any building. Posters may be placed on designated bulletin boards.

We encourage exhibitors to hang posters and displays on their stables and surround areas provided it does not impede the walkway or other exhibitor's stables.

Stabling

All bookings must be made through AELEC. Visit the website – www.aelec.com.au or call (02) 6767 5858. IMHR will post information on our website and social networking sites about the online booking system once AELEC has advised that it is available.

IMHR Inc. recommends the use of disinfectant in all shared horse areas including the stables and recommends that you bring suitable items for that purpose to assist in protecting the health of your horse.

AELEC requires that all exhibitors pay a stable deposit that will be refunded when stable is confirmed clean. ALL bedding must be removed (not just manure) and placed into designated areas. We recommend bringing a wheelbarrow and shovels for this purpose.

Camping & Parking

All bookings must be made through AELEC. Visit the website - www.aelec.com.au or call (02) 6767 5858.

If you have booked a caravan, you must pay additional parking for that caravan plus any other additional vehicles. Ensure your parking spot is suitable for your caravan before booking.

All parking behind the secure gates MUST BE PAID FOR. Free parking outside the secure gates is available for visitors. Checks will be made to ensure all vehicles are eligible. Ensure your pass is displayed on your vehicle. Anyone found parking or camping without paying the appropriate fee will be asked to leave and may be excluded from further participation in the National Show without refund.

Washing & Clipping Horses

Please be mindful of the water restrictions in place all over Australia and ensure you wash your horses using the minimum amount of water and do not leave hoses running.

Horses must be washed in designated wash bays only. No clipping of horses permitted in wash bays.

Horses may be clipped in stable areas however all hair must be swept up and placed in bins provided. Horses may be presented with heads and bodies clipped. Eyelashes are not to be removed.

Class Information

The age of youth & adult exhibitors is determined by <u>actual age as at closing date</u> for entries. For Three Day Event competitors, age is based on actual age at first event of the 3DE competition.

Marshalling

Exhibitors must be present in the marshalling area at least 5 minutes before the end of the previous class. Notification of gear and handler changes must be made to the Gate Steward and if time permits, a maximum 3 minute allowance will be made. All equipment required for gear and handler changes must be brought to the marshalling area.

Appropriate footwear (no thongs or sandals) must be worn in the marshalling area or you will be asked to leave the area. Failure to do so may result in disciplinary action.

It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to ensure that they monitor the progress of the classes and are present in time for their classes. They must also ensure that they have sufficient handlers, gear and equipment to ensure arrival for classes in a timely manner.

Any horse not listed in the steward sheet for that class will NOT be permitted to enter the ring. Changes in class entries due to heights or substitution must be annotated on the steward's sheet by Show Management or the exhibitor must hold the appropriate authorisation paperwork to present to the steward. Ensure you are at the marshalling area in time to resolve any issues.

Show Breaks

Exhibitors should note that there will be breaks during the program at the Judge and Stewards discretion.

Breaks will be announced periodically and displayed on the Show Office noticeboard where possible.

<u>Judges</u>

International judges plus local judges will be utilised during the National Show. Allocation of judges to events will be determined by IMHR based on availability.

AMHA USA Australian Titles



All American Miniature Horse Association (AMHA) classes will run under the rules of the AMHA (www.amha.org). All other rules specified in this premium relate to open classes only and do not apply to AMHA classes.

All horses participating in AMHA classes must be registered AMHA. Exhibitors must send in a copy of the horse's registration papers, front and back and senior stallions 3 years old and older must provide a Stallion Verification Report for the testicles with entry.

Novice Classes

These classes are restricted to handlers or exhibits that have never won a National Champion award in equivalent classes at a National Show.

The following sections of the program have novice events:

- Youth Showmanship, Trail and Hunter
- Harness (Driver and Horse)
- Adult Showmanship

For Novice Youth events, the exhibitor must not have won a Champion in any Youth event at National level.

For Novice Driver, the exhibitor must not have won a Champion in any harness event at National level.

For Novice Harness Horse, the horse must not have won a Champion in any harness event at National level.

For Adult Showmanship, the exhibitor must not have won a Champion showmanship class at National level.

Guinness World Record



The Guinness Book of World Records has officially approved IMHR to attempt to break an existing high jump record by a Miniature Horse.

The following conditions apply to this event:

- Entry fee per horse must be paid in full
- Horse must not exceed 38"
- Horse must be registered IMHR Inc.
- Horse must be over 3 years actual age

Safety of horse and handler is paramount. If at any stage, an official determines that the horse is unsound or it would be unsafe to continue, the horse may be retired from the event.

This event will run as follows:

- Jump will be set at the initial height of 34"
- Each horse will be given two attempts at each height
- Faulting twice at the same height results in disqualification of that exhibit
- Overall winner shall be permitted to make attempts at a higher level

The final two horses will be filmed as per guidelines set by Guinness World Records to ensure record attempt is captured.

Concurrent Classes - Ring 2

National Trail and the 3DE Cross Country Obstacle & Dressage classes will be set-up in a separate ring in the main arena and will run concurrently with the events in the main arena.

You will be able to choose a time that suits you within the published timeframes. See noticeboard at the show for patterns and official start times.

Please ensure you allow yourself enough time to complete the course before the cut-off time.

Volunteers

We are always looking for helpers for the National Show. If you are able to spare some time to assist at the show, please contact the Secretary. All assistance is appreciated.

Amateur Showcase

Entry to the National Amateur Showcase is subject to the following criteria:

- Exhibitor to be financial member of IMHR,
- Exhibitor to be the registered owner of the horse exhibited,
- Horse exhibited must be registered IMHR, and,
- Exhibitor must meet eligibility requirements for amateur (below).

For horse show purposes, a person is considered an amateur when he or she is <u>no longer eligible to compete in youth classes</u> and has not engaged in any activities, except as a youth, during the past five (5) calendar years which are listed below:

- Having accepted remuneration in the last five (5) years for showing any horse at halter or in performance competition, training, schooling either horses or other persons.
- Having accepted remuneration in the last five
 (5) years for having conducted seminars, clinics, given instruction in showing, training or judging.
- Having accepted remuneration in the last five (5) years for judging or being a horse breed association judge or horse show association judge.
- An individual who has had entry fees paid or has received prize money would still be considered an amateur.
- In the last 5 years received \$30K or more in a financial year for horses sold or sold on consignment.

Any person who does not qualify under these rules and shall knowingly and falsely represent to be an amateur in order to show in any classes for amateurs and/or any person who violates any of the provisions of this rule shall be subject to disciplinary action.

Protests regarding amateur eligibility must be made to the Protest Committee at least one hour prior to commencement of the amateur classes.

There is no requirement for the owner / exhibitor to have trained or prepared the exhibit prior to or during the show. If you have any questions regarding eligibility for these classes please confirm before entries close.

Awards for National Champion Amateur will be as per the National Champion halter classes.

Liberty Classes

Horses must be a minimum of 12 months (actual age) to enter these classes. Music for your liberty class must be supplied on CD in audio format.

One song per horse per CD ONLY.

CD must be labelled in permanent marker (no sticky notes) with:

- Liberty Class Number entered
- Horse's full registered name
- Exhibitor's full name

Please ensure that you have the correct class number especially if you have measured into a different height category.

Correctly formatted and labelled CD's must be presented to Show Office by midday Friday to allow time for testing of media or entry to class shall be refused. It is a condition of entry that you accept this rule. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to provide an alternate option if the media is found to be defective or not compatible with the equipment at AELEC.

CDs will be available for collection at the end of the show at the Show Office. CDs not collected will be disposed of.

Run order will be as per catalogue.

Double Shot

Entry to the Double Shot classes is open to all horses and exhibitors meeting standard eligibility for entry to the National Show. These classes are judged by two judges who will each award their individual placing.

Broodmares

To be eligible to show as a broodmare, the mare must be in foal, have a foal at foot or have foaled in the last season. Proof must be produced on request.

Mares may be entered in either the open mare or broodmare class – not both.

SIRES Futurities

Entry to the SIRES Futurities is restricted to progeny from pre-nominated sires. This is a Prize Money event. Prize money is awarded to the exhibitor and totalled by sire. This tally will continue each year.

Champion of Champions

All National Grand Champion halter winners in eligible National classes must parade for the Champion of Champions unless a veterinary certificate is produced.

Failure to parade without certificate may result in all awards for that exhibitor being revoked.



Coloured Classes

Horses may only enter ONE colour class. Judging is based on PHENOTYPE (the way the horse looks) and not GENOTYPE (the genetic colour of the horse). Judging is 80% colour and 20% conformation.

Non-pinto silvers and taffies enter the Silver class. Pintaloosa's and horses with multiple patterns and/or colours (i.e. dilute pinto, taffy appaloosa etc..) should enter the Any Other Colour class.

Exhibits may only enter one colour class.

Harness / Long-Reining



For the protection of horses and exhibitors, all harness exhibitors MUST provide a header for all harness events. The header must be 16 years old or over and must remain in the marshalling area and provide immediate assistance if required.

Any harness exhibits that are considered unsafe or unsound by Show Management will be asked to leave the arena.

Whips are required for long-reining and all harness driven classes.

Winkers are required for harness driving however, are optional for long-reining classes.

Hi Point Calculation

Calculations for Hi Point Breeder and Hi Point IMHR Exhibitor are calculated as follows:

AMHA, Shetland, 3DE, Amateur, Novice, SIRES, Fancy Dress and Youth events are not included for overall Hi Point Breeder and Exhibitor awards.

Multiple Judge System

Judged by two or three judges who will present an individual placing to the steward. Placing will be awarded points as follows:

1st	1 point	4 th	4 points
2^{nd}	2 points	5^{th}	5 points
3 rd	3 points	6^{th}	6 points

All unplaced horses in the class get 7 points. Sashes are awarded to 6th place.

Scores are tallied and the horse with the lowest score is deemed the winner. The horse with the next lowest scored is deemed second and so on.

A casting vote judge will be nominated for each class prior to the calculation of results. The casting vote judge will normally rotate between the judges for each class. In the event of a tie, the horse that placed higher by the nominated casting vote judge shall be deemed to have placed higher than the horse on the same number of points.

Show Management reserve the right to change the number of judges in the event of judge unavailability.

Prize Money Events

Prize pool is based on entry fee and number of exhibit entering the ring (not catalogued - due to height changes and scratching).

Amounts are determined by the following calculation:

1st 40 % prize pool

2nd 20 % prize pool

3rd 10 % prize pool

State of Origin Challenge



The IMHR National Show will again host the State of Origin challenge.

This event consists of 3 adult and 3 youth exhibitors from each state.

Each pre-nominated exhibitor will compete in their respective Showmanship, Hunter and Trail events.

Rules for Showmanship, Trail and Hunter are as per the official IMHR Performance Handbook.

On completion of the event, the placings for each of the six events are announced and ribbons are awarded.

Points are awarded as follows: 1st – 6 points through to 1 point for 6th place.

The team with the highest number of points is declared the winner.

Youth and adult exhibitors wishing to compete in the event must indicate on their entry form. If nominations exceed available placings, names shall be drawn at random.

Exhibitors must enter all three events and if using more than one horse in their events, must pre-nominate the horse to be used in each event.

Best Dressed Stables

Exhibitors are encouraged to decorate their stables to promote their horses and studs.

To be eligible to win, photos are to be sent to office@imhr.com.au once stable display is setup and they will be placed on the IMHR Facebook page by IMHR. The photos with the most number of 'Likes' by Saturday midday will determine the winner!

Winner will receive \$50 cash and a trophy.

Three Day Event

To be held as part of the National Show. The rules/point system is based on Equestrian Australia (formerly EFA) rules adjusted for miniature horses.



Open to senior horses only - mares, geldings and stallions aged 3 years and over (actual age).

Competitors must be aged 13 or over on the first day of the event.

How it works

Eventing is a test of your horse's fitness, athleticism, stamina and obedience. It consists of three phases:

- 1 x Dressage In Hand test
- 1 x Show Jumping round
- 1 x Cross country/Obstacle course

The winner is the competitor with the **highest total** score across all three components.

The same combination of horse and handler must complete in all three phases. You may enter more than one horse. Entry fee applies per horse and covers the three events.

See the IMHR Three Day Event booklet for more information on this exciting event.

Breeders \$weepstakes

This class has been introduced on a trial basis.

All exhibits in this event must be bred and shown by the owner. Prize pool is based on entry fee and number of exhibits entered as per catalogue.

This is a Prize Money event.





Ridden Class (Lead-line)

This class has been introduced on a trial basis and is a demonstration event. The following guidelines apply:

- This class is for youth exhibitors three to eight years of age as of date of show and the rider must show some knowledge of equitation
- Riders must be led or accompanied by a competent handler aged 16 years and over
- Horses must be at least 3 years actual age
- Horses must be over 34"
- For horses 34" 35" riders must be under 18 kg
- For horses over 35" riders must be under 28 kg
- All riders must wear a helmet.
- Horses must be bitted.
- Horse may be plaited
- English or western attire is acceptable but must correspond with equipment
- Equipment on the horse must correspond with exhibitor attire, including a saddle adjusted so that the exhibitor's feet are placed properly in stirrups.
- Equipment must be of appropriate size for horse and rider
- This class will not count towards Youth Hi Points
- A lead shank at least six feet long must be attached to the shank of the bit or to a halter that is under the bridle so that while the rider is in the ring, the horse is able to be controlled by the adult.

RING PROCEDURE: The exhibitors will enter the ring with feet properly placed in stirrups at a flat-footed walk turning to the right and proceeding in a counter clockwise direction on the rail. The class will be worked at a walk or trot both directions of the ring.

In the lineup, the judge may ask riders to back their horses to help him judge the extent of the rider's horsemanship. If the judge asks the rider to back the horse in the lineup, the adult should not aid the rider. The adult should only keep the horse under control.

JUDGING THE RIDER: The rider will be judged on their basic position in the saddle, hand, leg, feet in stirrups, seat and back position.



Special Awards

The National Show will host the following special awards:

Hi Point Breeder

- Kerrie Shaw Memorial Trophy

The winner of this award is determined by a combined score of all placing of horses based on their breeders (stud) prefix. The winner does not have to be a member of IMHR Inc.

Hi Point IMHR Exhibitor

- Trophy

The winner of this award is determined by a combined score of all placings won by the exhibitor. Winner must be a current financial member of IMHR.

Hi Point AMHA Exhibitor

- Trophy

The winner of these awards is determined based on results in the American Miniature Horse section. This is not part of the AMHA approved program and is provided by IMHR.

Hi Point Youth Exhibitor

& Runner Up

The winner of these awards is determined by the results of the Youth section including performance but excluding novice. All ages are eligible.

Hi Point Harness Exhibitor

& Runner Up

The winner of these awards is determined based on results in the Harness section (including long-reining) of the National program. All heights are eligible.

Ultimate Gelding Of The Year

To be judged at the conclusion of the Little Horse halter classes. Junior and Senior Miniature Horse, Small Horse and Little Horse Grand Champion Geldings are eligible. Miniature ponies are not eligible.

Aziz Farasha Perpetual Trophy

Awarded to the winner of the Miniature Horse Senior Liberty. Winner is recorded on perpetual trophy and will also receive a trophy. Proudly sponsored by Meambie Minis.

Grand Championships

All first and second place getters in eligible National halter classes must present for the Grand Championship awards unless officially scratched.

Grand Champion Youth Exhibitors

The winner of these awards is determined by the results of the respective Youth Showmanship, Trail and Hunter classes. In the event of a tie, the exhibitor with the highest trail score is deemed the winner. Any further tiebreaks are decided by the judge.

Grand Champion Harness

The winner of these awards is determined by the result of the Harness Mare, Harness Stallion and Harness Gelding classes only. No other harness events are included in the Grand Champion. Exhibits must work out for the Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion.

Grand Champion Performance

The winner of these awards is determined by the results of the Trail, Hunter and Lunge-line classes. In the event of a tie, the exhibit with the highest trail score is deemed the winner. Any further tie-breaks are decided by the judge.

Miniature Pony Grand Champion performance is decided by results of trail and hunter.

Grand Champion Jumper

The winner of these awards is determined by the results of the Show Jumper, Fault & Out and Six Bar classes. In the event of a tie, the exhibit with the best Fault & Out result is deemed the winner. Any further tie-breaks are decided by the judge.

Each exhibitor will be liable for injury that may be occasioned to any person or animal or damage to property while on the grounds by any horse owned, exhibited by, or in his/her custody/control and shall indemnify and hold harmless the Independent Miniature Horse Registry Inc.

Force Majeure

IMHR Inc shall not be liable for any delay or failure to perform its operations, activities, shows and events to the extent such delay or failure results from a force majeure occurrence.

A force majeure occurrence is defined as any occurrence arising from causes beyond the reasonable control of IMHR Inc. and which delays or prevents performance by IMHR Inc. required by this agreement, otherwise including but not limited to any (i) breakage or accident to equipment, machinery or facilities; (ii) any strikes, lock-outs or other labor difficulties; (iii) statutes, ordinances, regulations, orders, or rules issued by governmental authorities; (iv) judicial decrees or orders; (v) acts of God; (vi) animal diseases and/or quarantines; (vii) wars, riots or insurrections; (viii) civil disobediences, public demonstrations or sabotage; (ix) fires, floods, explosions or inclement weather; (x) inability to obtain necessary labor, materials, supplies, utilities or transportation; (xi) depressions, recessions or other economic downturns; (xii) embargoes or energy shortages; or (xiii) other causes beyond the IMHR's reasonable control.



Hendra & Biosecurity

Vaccination for the Hendra virus is not compulsory but is recommended. Please discuss with your veterinarian.

Biosecurity measures WILL be enforced. Anyone found to be breaching these measures will be asked to leave the venue.

These measures include but are not limited to:

- Routine use of safe systems of work for all contact with horses, horse blood and body fluids, and associated equipment. This includes
 - washing hands regularly
 - maintaining standards of cleanliness and stable hygiene
 - cleaning and disinfecting equipment that has been in contact with horses' body fluids.
- If you have a sick horse, isolate it from other horses, people and animals (e.g. remove companion animals to another area) until you have obtained a veterinary opinion.
- Clean and disinfect all gear exposed to any body fluids from horses before using it on another horse. This includes halters, lead ropes and twitches.
- When cleaning contaminated equipment from a sick horse, wear gloves, cover any cuts or grazes and wash your hands thoroughly afterwards.
- Practise good biosecurity and do not travel with, work on or take sick horses to other properties or equestrian events.
- Do not allow visiting horse practitioners (e.g. farriers) to work on sick horses.
- Seek veterinary advice before bringing any sick horse onto your property.

IMHR Officials reserve the right to exclude from competition any horse showing any symptoms of illness (i.e nasal discharge etc.)

Stewards and officials will NOT be permitted to touch any horse for any reason. Ribbons will be handed to exhibitors by the Ring Steward. Exhibitors may place the ribbon, garland on the horse for photographs etc.

Judges and Stewards will enforce bio-security in the ring including the use of hand sanitisers before each class.
